The meeting was called to order at 6:20 p.m.

Susanna asked if everyone had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. She made a motion to approve them. Mary seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

Anheuser Busch's "Spykes" – Susanna asked Jim his opinion on the situation – where are kids getting it and how do we prevent that? He said that most kids get alcohol from their parents or they find someone to buy it for them. There's not much you can do to prevent it – other than boycotting the product.

Mary – met with Metropolitan Family Services, a member of the School Board, CCSO and the DA's Office – they're looking at more after school programs. They're targeting Lot Whitcomb School right now, especially the at-risk kids. They want to develop a website that will list all the activities that are available to kids. They will be meeting every month and she will attend.

There was a discussion regarding Light Rail. Susanna wanted to know why they had to include artwork in the budget but they don't seem to put security as a priority.

Cheryl said the Campbell PTA carnival was a big success – having the Cadets and Explorers there with the police vehicles was great. There was a discussion regarding safety in the parks. There are usually juveniles hanging out there, smoking – and alcoholic beverage containers have been left behind. Jim said to call if there is suspicious activity going on.

Safe Route To School program – it's a statewide activity. The first part of the application for funding is \$1,000 to cover the planning. Then identifying what the project will be, such as sidewalks, skateboard racks, etc. The most you can get is \$250,000. Susanna has all the materials. The deadline is the end of July. There will be another round next Spring.

There was a discussion on the shooting scenario training through the Citizens' and FBI Academies.

Jim gave an update on the injured police officers.
