DISCUSSION OF URBAN COUNTY FUNDING APPLICATION

Following the interviews, with the above Councilmembers present, as well as Dorothy E. Farrell, Secretary, the Council discussed urban county funding projects as recommended by County staff. County staff is recommending Ardenwald storm drains and street improvements and Water Tower Park improvements in Ardenwald, for a total of \$126,000. These projects were number 4 and number 2 on the city's priority list. Also included under Milwaukie's allocation by the county are Hillside Park and Hillside Manor public housing modernization, which were not requested by Milwaukie. Mayor stated county does not rank Ardenwald high as a neighborhood revitalization area. It was Council consensus to ask the county to move the Hillside Park and Hillside Manor projects out of Milwaukie's section of projects, and to try to get somewhere between \$200,000 and \$250,000 for Milwaukie projects.
