A special meeting of the Milwaukie City Council was held at 7 p.m. February 25, 1980, with the following councilpersons present:

The meeting was called for the purpose of holding a public hearing on Federal Revenue Sharing.

Madeline Bohl, representing Milwaukie Historical Society, requested \$2500 from Revenue Sharing to cover operating costs for the next year. Council referred request to Budget Committee.

Georgia Brakeman, Budget Committee, asked about funding for Community Center transportation; Manager said this would be presented to Budget Committee.

Council raised question as to dependence on Revenue Sharing; consensus was to cut dependence in future. Nickel asked that staff write a strong letter in support of Revenue Sharing extension. Ewald said the League of Oregon Cities recommends not budgeting Revenue Sharing until certain it will be forthcoming.

James Backenstos, Budget Committee, asked for more emphasis on youth recreation programs.

Burgess asked for staff report on alternatives for use of Revenue Sharing funds.

Don Sellwood, 3624 SE Rockwood, asked about duplexes to be built on Rockwood; he was referred to staff.
