1. **Library Board**

City Council met in joint session with the Library Board and discussed fundraising efforts for the addition. Council agreed that fundraising efforts should begin, and Councilmember Fitzgerald was appointed as coordinator.

Board members also inquired about the effect of levy failure on the library. They urged Council to specify what the levy would pay for, and Council responded they were not yet prepared to do so. The Board asked to be informed if cuts were imminent so they might suggest alternatives.

3. **Boat Ramp**


Council agreed to allow staff to discuss a compromise with Knappton for log removal from the City lease area.
