KEY FACTS & INFORMATION SUMMARY

Leaders from across the region adopted the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) in 2010, setting the direction for creating an innovative, sustainable transportation system.

Oregon law now requires Portland area cities and counties to update their local transportation system plan's (TSP) to be consistent with the new RTP. Currently, communities around the region, including Milwaukie and Clackamas County, are updating their local TSP's to bring the RTP vision to life in a way that also supports their aspirations and needs.
