

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1368

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE CITY'S ELECTION TO RECEIVE STATE REVENUE SHARING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That pursuant to C-Engrossed SB11, adopted by the 1977 legislative assembly, the City of Milwaukie hereby elects to receive state revenue sharing funds for the fiscal year 1977-78.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and best interests of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.


Read the first time this 18th day of July, 1977 and passed to its second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.
