

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1377

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1028 BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 1028 shall be amended to include:


"(11) Harborage for rats. It is unlawful for any person who owns and/or is in charge of property to allow the accumulation of any litter, filth, garbage, decaying animal or vegetable matter, which may or does offer harborage or source of food for rats."

Section 2. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this amendment to this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and best interests of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.


Read the first time this 7th day of November, 1977, and moved to second reading by majority vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council this 21st day of November, 1977.


