

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1379

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1349, AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A BUSINESS TAX, AND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1350, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LICENSING BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS, OCCUPATIONS AND RENTAL PROPERTIES.

The City of Milwaukie Does Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Ordinance Number 1349 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection 6.e.:

"e. The City Manager or his designee shall have the authority to waive a delinquency charge when, in his judgement, circumstances are such that a delinquency charge should not be assessed."

Section 2. That Section 8 of Ordinance Number 1349 is hereby amended by adding the following wording:

"Relocation of the business to a new location shall constitute a new business and shall require the payment of a business tax upon that new business,"


Section 3. That Section 8 of Ordinance Number 1350 is hereby amended by adding the following wording:

"Relocation of the business to a new location shall constitute a new business and shall require the owner to obtain a business license for that new business."


Read the first time this 19th day of December, 1977, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council this 19th day of December, 1977.


