

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1398

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1378; WHICH AMENDED ORDINANCE NUMBER 1310, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SIGNS; AND REVIVING THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1310; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That due to the repeal of Ordinance No. 1344, dealing with Design Review, it is necessary to repeal Ordinance No. 1378, which provided an appeal of Sign Ordinance interpretations to the Design Review Board; therefore, Ordinance No. 1378 is hereby repealed in total.


Section 2. Ordinance No. 1310, an ordinance regulating the construction, erection, maintenance, electrification, illumination, type, size number and location of signs in areas outside the public right-of-way in the City of Milwaukie is hereby revived in its original language as adopted by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie on the 21st day of April, 1975.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, peace, safety and in the best interests of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and the signing of the Mayor.

Read the first time this 6th day of July, 1978, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.


Read the second time and adopted by the City Council this 17th day of July, 1978.
