

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1399

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A TIME FOR CURFEW ON THAT PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE LEDDING LIBRARY AND SCOTT PARK; PROVIDING PENALTIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person not exempted by this ordinance to voluntarily and knowingly roam or be upon the areas more particularly described hereinafter, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

Section 2. The property covered under this ordinance covers the Ledding Library of Milwaukie and its grounds, except for public sidewalks adjacent to S.E. Harrison and S.E. 21st Streets, said library and grounds being located at 10600 S.E. 21st Street, Milwaukie, Oregon; and that property constituting Scott Park in Milwaukie, Oregon, said property being located adjacent to and north of the Ledding Library of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 3. Persons Exempted. The following persons are exempted from this ordinance: employees of the City of Milwaukie on official business, and emergency or technical service personnel requested by the City of Milwaukie to perform duties on said premises.


Section 4. Penalties. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$300, or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, peace, safety, and the best interests of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.


Read the first time this 7th day of August, 1978, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council this 7th day of August, 1978.


