

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1413

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1371, ESTABLISHING SEWER RATE REDUCTIONS FOR CERTAIN LOW INCOME UTILITY CUSTOMERS, AND REQUIRING AN ANNUAL REVIEW OF USER FEES (SEWER CHARGES) FOR ADEQUACY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Milwaukie Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1371 is hereby amended as follows:

~~Financing of Program. Sewer-charges-to-non-qualifying-users~~ Subsidies from the General Fund shall be established at a level sufficient to cover revenue losses resulting from reduced utility rates to qualified applicants.

Section 2. An annual review of user fees (sewer charges) shall be prepared to determine the adequacy of rates. Rates shall be deemed adequate if they are sufficient to provide a level of revenues which will cover operating costs, depreciation, system maintenance, debt retirement and all other obligations of the Sewer Fund.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and best interest of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 9th day of November, 1978.

Read the second time and passed by unanimous vote of the Council this 9th day of November, 1978.


