

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1448

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1381 PROVIDING FOR ANIMAL CONTROL.

The City of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 3(B) of Ordinance Number 1381 is amended to read as follows:

- B) Animal Control Shelter means the dog pound or kennel operated or contracted for by the Clackamas County Animal Control Shelter or such other animal retention facility utilized from time to time to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

Section 2. Section 9(A) of Ordinance Number 1381 is amended to read as follows:

- A) Each person owning or keeping any dog that has a set of permanent canine teeth or is six months old, whichever occurs first, shall pay a license fee and obtain a license from the Animal Control Officer of the City of Milwaukie before March 1 of each year or within thirty (30) days after he becomes the owner or keeper of the dog.

Section 3. Section 10(B) of Ordinance Number 1381 is amended to read as follows:

- B) The Clackamas County Animal Control and the City of Milwaukie Animal Control Officer shall maintain records showing the breed, sex, color and markings of the impounded dog and the date the dog will be released to a new owner or destroyed unless claimed and redeemed, which date shall not be less than five (5) days after impoundment.

Section 4. Section 10(D) of Ordinance Number 1381 is amended to read as follows:

- D) If the impounded dog is not redeemed by its owner or keeper within the time fixed under (B) above, it may be released to any person upon payment to the City of Milwaukie Animal Control or Clackamas County Animal Control of the impoundment fees and charges. The owner or keeper may still redeem the dog within thirty (30) days after the date of impoundment by paying the impoundment fees and charges and, upon releasing any dog to a person other than the owner or keeper, Clackamas County Animal Control shall obtain a written receipt acknowledging that the person holds the dog subject to claim of the owner or keeper.


Section 5. Section 10 (E) of Ordinance Number 1381 is amended to read as follows:

- E) Any person redeeming a dog from quarantine or impoundment shall pay all impoundment fees and charges. If the dog is not licensed, the person redeeming the dog shall pay an additional amount as a refundable deposit to be returned when the dog is licensed. The person shall have (8) calendar days to obtain a license; a penalty fee may be charged if a license is not obtained within this time period.


Read the first time this 21st day of February, 1980 and moved to second reading by majority vote of the Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the Council this 3rd day of March, 1980.



ORDINANCE NUMBER 1450

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 1106 (PLANNING COMMISSION) AND 1284 (TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION).

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The eighth sentence of Section 2 of Ordinance Number 1106 is amended to read as follows:

No person may serve more than two consecutive four-year terms, provided that the City Council may waive this limitation if it is in the best interest of the city to do so.

Section 2. The sixth sentence of Section 2 of Ordinance Number 1284 is amended to read as follows:

Members may not serve more than two consecutive two-year terms, provided that the City Council may waive this limitation if it is in the best interest of the city to do so.


Read the first time on March 17, 1980, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.
