

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1469

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE ADOPTING THE STATE OF OREGON BUILDING CODES, TOGETHER WITH ALL SUPPLEMENTS AND APPURTENANCES, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1290, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby adopted the State of Oregon Uniform Building Code, current edition, and State of Oregon Uniform Mechanical Code, current edition, together with the appurtenances attached thereto, as published by the State of Oregon, Department of Commerce, Building Codes Division, Salem, Oregon, and current editions of the Uniform Housing Code, Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, Uniform Sign Code, Uniform Building Code Standards together with the appurtenances attached thereto, as copyrighted by International Conference of Building Officials. One copy of each is on file in the office of the City Recorder. All fees shall be determined and set by resolution of the City Council.

Section 2. Chapter 70 of the Uniform Building Code is expressly adopted.


Section 3. Ordinance Number 1290 is repealed.

Section 4. Because this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and best interests of the inhabitants of the city, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time on July 7, 1980, and moved to second reading by majority vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on July 21, 1980.
