

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1503

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AMENDING VARIOUS ORDINANCES BY ELIMINATING REFERENCES TO IMPRISONMENT.

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that imprisonment penalties for violation of certain ordinances should be repealed in order to avoid legal costs associated with the criminal prosecution of these offenses, now therefore,


