

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1607

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, VACATING A PORTION OF MYRTLE STREET.

WHEREAS, the Council initiated this vacation on August 5, 1986, and

WHEREAS, after proper notice, a hearing was held before the Council on October 7, 1986, in accordance with ORS Chapter 271,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The City Council finds that notice has been duly given of the hearing on this vacation, there are insufficient objections to prevent the vacation under ORS 271.130 and the vacation is in the public interest.

Section 2. Vacation. The following described street is vacated:

Myrtle Street from Washington Street to Highway 224, reserving, however, a blanket utility easement be maintained over the entire public right-of-way for City and private utilities.

Section 3. Filing. The Public Works Director is directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Clerk, Assessor and Surveyor for Clackamas County, Oregon.

Read the first time October 7, 1986, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on October 7, 1986.




