

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1610

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, PROHIBITING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON A PORTION OF JOHNSON CREEK BLVD.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City of Milwaukie shall not directly, indirectly or through any agency enter into any agreement approving or facilitating, or otherwise authorize or permit traffic of motor trucks possessing more than two axles to proceed through the City of Milwaukie by travelling upon any portion of Johnson Creek Boulevard within the boundaries of the City of Milwaukie that is located west of Brookside Drive.

Section 2. As used in this section, "motor truck " means a motor vehicle that is primarily designed or used for carrying loads other than passengers, possesses more than two axles, and conforms with the definition of "truck tractor" under ORS 801.575 and "truck trailer" under ORS 801.580.

Section 3. This measure shall take effect within thirty (30) days after its passage.


Proposed by initiative petition on July 21, 1986.
