

ORDINANCE NO. 1614

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ADOPTING THE MILWAUKIE MUNICIPAL CODE.**

**WHEREAS**, all general ordinances of the City have been codified in a volume entitled the Milwaukie Municipal Code, and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to adopt the Code to make it enforceable and allow for its periodic amendment, therefore,

**THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Chapter 1.01 Code Adoption is added to the Milwaukie Municipal Code as follows:

1.01.010 Title.

The Milwaukie Municipal Code is adopted as the official City Code of the City of Milwaukie. The code shall be cited as the "Milwaukie Code", published under general authority of the City Council and maintained as provided in this Chapter by the City Attorney.

1.01.020 Acceptance.

The Milwaukie Code shall be received without further proof in all courts and administrative tribunals of the State of Oregon as the ordinances of the City of general and permanent effect.

1.01.030 Amendments.

Any ordinance amending this code shall set forth the title, chapter and section number of the section or sections amended. The Code will be updated at least annually by insertion of replacement pages in each copy maintained by the City.

1.01.040 Jurisdiction.

Unless otherwise provided in this Code, the code applies to acts performed within the Corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie. Provisions of the Code also apply to acts performed outside the corporate limits of the City where state or other law grants the City power to regulate particular acts outside the corporate limits.

1.01.050 Copies on file.

Copies of this code will be maintained in all City departments and copies available for public inspection will be maintained at the Ledding Library and Office of the City Manager in City Hall.

1.01.060 Ordinances passed prior to code adoption.

The last ordinance included in the original code is Ordinance No. 1592, passed March 18, 1986. The following ordinances, passed subsequent to Ordinance No. 1592, but prior to adoption of this code, are hereby adopted and made part of this code: Ordinance Nos. 1597, 1601, 1606, 1608, 1610, and 1611.

1.01.070 Severability.




Read the first time on December 2, 1986, and moved to second reading by 3 - 0 vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on December 16, 1986, 1986.




