ORDINANCE NO. 1715

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1511, CODIFIED AS CHAPTER 5.32 OF THE MILWAUKIE MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF SECURITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, Chapter 5.32 of the Milwaukie Municipal Code was adopted in 1982 due to problems which were occurring at that time with certain security service businesses; and

WHEREAS, there have been no recent complaints regarding a security service operator; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 5.32 has numerous regulations which the Chief of Police is responsible for enforcing; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department does not have adequate staff to correctly enforce the provisions of Chapter 5.32; and

WHEREAS, the fee which is currently charged for the licensing of security services does not "defray the direct and indirect costs to the city in investigating applicants, monitoring the security service business and administering the provisions of this chapter" as set out in Section 5.32.080 of the Milwaukie Municipal Code; now, therefore:


THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1511, as amended by Ordinance No. 1654, Section 2 (part), and codified as Chapter 5.32 of the Milwaukie Municipal Code is hereby repealed.


Read for the first time on December 3, 1991 and moved to a second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read for the second time and adopted by the City Council on December 3, 1991.


