

RESOLUTION NUMBER 39-1976

RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE VOTE AT ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 1976.

WHEREAS, at the same time as the State General Election on the 2nd day of November, 1976, there was also a vote to elect certain city officials of the City of Milwaukie, which was conducted and supervised by the Clackamas County Clerk, and

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Clerk has certified to the City of Milwaukie the vote of the people for Mayor and Councilmen,
