

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A REQUEST FOR ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE.

WHEREAS, a request has been made for annexation of the territory described on attached Exhibit A.

In the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon.

WHEREAS, the annexation of the territory to the City has been initiated by landowner's statement of consent, in accordance with ORS 222.170, and would therefore constitute a so-called "triple majority" annexation under ORS 222.170 and a "minor boundary change" under the boundary commission law, ORS 199.410 to 199.510; and,

WHEREAS, the part of the territory that lies in the Clackamas County Rural Fire Protection District No. 1 would, by operation of ORS 199.510 (2), be automatically withdrawn from that district immediately upon consummation of the annexation; and,

WHEREAS, the part of the territory that lies in the Stanley Water District, the Council intends, in the event the annexation is consummated, to withdraw from that district by authority of ORS 222.520,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, that:

Section 1. The Council hereby approves the proposed annexation and requests the Boundary Commission to approve it and effect it as soon as possible.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of the statements of consent and of this Resolution with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission at once.

Be it so resolved.

Being a portion of Tracts 11 and 12, GIBSON'S SUBDIVISION OF TRACTS NUMBERED 10, 11, 12, 13 and the west 480 feet of TRACTS NUMBERED 1 and 2 OF THE LOGUS TRACTS, situated in the D.L.C.s of George Mills and Hector Campbell, completely described as

Beginning at an iron pipe driven at the southwest corner of Tract 12, of Gibson's Subdivision of Tracts 10, 11, 12 and 13 and the west 480 feet of the Tracts numbered 1 and 2, of the Logus Tracts; running thence North 89° 30' East tracing the south boundary of Tract No. 12, 220 feet to an iron pipe driven at the southeast corner of said Tract; thence North 1° 15' West tracing the easterly boundary of Tract 12 and 11, a distance of 210.37 feet to a point in the center of Johnson Creek from which point an iron pipe driven on the left bank of said Creek bears South 1° 15' East 27.67 feet distant; thence tracing the center of Johnson Creek down stream North 82° 30' West 34.14 feet; thence tracing the center of Johnson Creek down stream on a 12° curve to the right through a central angle of 23° 48' a distance of 198.33 feet to a point on the west boundary of Tract 11, from which point an iron pipe driven on the left bank of Johnson Creek bears South 1° 15' East 31.73 feet distant; thence South 1° 15' East tracing the west boundary of Tracts 11 and 12 a distance of 182.50 feet to the point of beginning.
