

RESOLUTION NO. 21-1989

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON ESTABLISHING LOW INCOME LEVELS FOR SYSTEMS DEVELOPMENT CHARGE INSTALLMENT PAYMENT OR LOW INTEREST DEFERRAL PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, Milwaukie Municipal Code 3.16.055 identifies two types of low income programs for the payment of systems development charges, and

WHEREAS, the low income eligibility level is to be set by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that:

Section 1. To be eligible for the installment and deferred payment programs, the applicants total household income cannot exceed the levels listed in section 4 and 5 of this resolution.

Section 2. Acceptable proof of income level shall include the current federal tax return filed by the applicant, current W2 or current audited financial statement.

Section 3. The low income levels are based on federal poverty levels.


Section 4. Installment payments program. Low income levels are as follows:

1	\$11,960
2	16,040
3	20,120
4	24,200
Over 4 Each Additional	4,080


Section 5. Low interest 5 year deferral program. Low income levels are as follows:

Total # in Household	Total Annual Income
1	\$ 8,970
2	12,030
3	15,090
4	18,150
Over 4 Each Additional	3,060
