

RESOLUTION NUMBER 14-1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE
SETTING PASS-THROUGH RATE FOR DISPOSAL FEE INCREASE AND THE
COST OF IMPLEMENTING COUNTY-WIDE RECYCLING CONTAINER PROGRAM
UNDER ORDINANCE NUMBER 1301 AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NUMBER
32-1989.

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Ordinance 1301 dated
October 7, 1974, provides that the City Council shall establish
compensation for the contract rights to garbage franchises and
for the use of City streets, and

WHEREAS, Section 20 of Ordinance 1301 provides that
the City Council shall set rates to be charged by the garbage
franchisees by Council resolution, and


WHEREAS, the garbage haulers have requested a
pass-through rate increase based on an increase in disposal
fees at Metro South Transfer Station effective July 1, 1990 and
based on the county-wide recycling container program being
implemented on or about April 1, 1990,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council
of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the pass-through rate
for the disposal fee increase and the cost of implementing the
county-wide recycling container program be as set forth in
Exhibit "A" attached hereto, which is by reference made a part
hereof, and that said rates shall be as set forth on the
attached Exhibit "A" and shall be effective on the 1st day of
July, 1990.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the franchise fee
established at the rate of 2% of gross receipts beginning with
fiscal year 1990-91 as set forth in Resolution Number 32-1989,
scheduled to take effect on July 1, 1990, shall remain in full
force and effect. The franchise fee shall be paid quarterly
within 30 days of the end of each calendar quarter. A penalty
of 10% shall be added for payments received later than 40 days
after the end of each calendar quarter.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution Number

Additional stops per week for 32 gallon cans shall be served at 100% of the first stop per week rate.

Additional Residential Service:

Occasional service on the regular route day in the area is available upon notification of your collection at least 24 hours prior, or personal contact with the driver ("Yoo-Hoo" service) on the route as in the past.

The rate on a per can basis shall be:

II. 90 GALLON CART - RESIDENTIAL ROADSIDE RATE

The cart must be at roadside by 6:00 a.m. on the day of collection.

The rate per cart per month shall be:

One Collection per Week - per Cart	\$13.90	1.40	.15	.05	15.50
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Additional stop per week shall be served at 125% of the first stop per week rate.

A collector may require a deposit of \$30 at the time a cart is initially placed. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the cart or at the expiration of five (5) years, whichever first occurs, providing the cart is maintained in good condition under the care, custody and control of the customer (reasonable wear and tear excepted). A collector may refuse carts to any customer where the use is not compatible with the cart. Cart service will not be provided for commercial customers.

90 GALLON CART - COMMERCIAL ROADSIDE RATE

The cart must be at roadside by 6:00 a.m. on the day of collection. The rate per cart per month shall be:

One Collection Per Week - Per Cart	\$17.15	1.40	---	.05	18.60
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Additional stop per week shall be served at 125% of the first stop per week rate.

A collector may require a deposit of \$30 at the time a cart is initially placed. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the cart or at the expiration of five (5) years, whichever first occurs, providing the cart is maintained in good condition under the care, custody and control of the customer (reasonable wear and tear excepted). A collector may refuse carts to any customer where the use is not compatible with the cart.

The weight limit for both residential and commercial carts shall be 120 pounds.

Additional containers shall be served at 90% of the first container rate. Additional stops per week shall be served at 90% of the first stop per week rates. The collector shall furnish the containers.

B. Compacted Material - one stop per week, first container:

Additional containers shall be served at 90% of the first container rate. Additional stops per week shall be served at 90% of the first stop per week rates. Compactors furnished by the customers shall be compatible with the equipment of the collector. If the collector agrees to furnish the compactor, the collector may charge a reasonable rental fee based on the value of the compactor and the cost of repair and maintenance.

IV. DROP BOX SERVICE

A. Loose Material - for repeat customers:

An additional \$19.55 per drop box may be charged for one-stop service (plus disposal costs). A reasonable deposit for disposal costs may be charged.

VI. ANY OTHER TYPE OF SERVICE

If, due to changes in technology or needs of residents and business people of Milwaukie, additional or other types of services are needed, the charge for the service shall not be discriminatory, shall be reasonable by being commensurate with the rates above, and shall not exceed the rates most generally applicable in the Portland Metropolitan area.
