

RESOLUTION NUMBER 12-1992

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, CALLING AN ELECTION ON MAY 19, 1992 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING A NEW TAX BASE TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on February 17, 1992, pursuant to ORS 310.186, to discuss impact of a new tax base for the City of Milwaukie: and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee has reviewed the 1992-1993 financial situation of the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, additional revenue sources are required to prevent reductions to current service levels; and

WHEREAS, approval of a new tax base for the City would reduce the property tax collections of other nonschool district units of government available under the provisions of section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution and implementing legislation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed tax base is subject to the limits of section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution and must be submitted to the voters of the City for their approval; and

WHEREAS, ORS 310.402 requires tax base elections to be held only at regular statewide general or primary elections

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie that:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie hereby certifies that they have complied with the requirements of ORS 310.180 to 310.188. The city has participated in the tax coordination process and has held the special public hearing required by ORS 310.186(1) on February 17, 1992.

Section 2. An election is hereby called in and for the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon on Tuesday, May 19, 1992, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City the question of establishing a new tax base.

Section 3. The following ballot is hereby approved and shall be printed on the official ballot as set forth below:

**CAPTION:** TO ESTABLISH A TAX BASE

**QUESTION:** Shall Milwaukie be authorized a \$5,143,671 tax base beginning with the 1992-1993 fiscal year?

**EXPLANATION:** The new tax base will allow the City to continue to provide existing service levels. It will provide funding for police, fire, emergency medical response, library, and general governmental services.

The City has operated within this base for six of the last seven years. The current tax base is \$3,936,568. It pays for over one half of the City's general fund services.

The estimated tax rate for this levy is \$6.1195. This compares to \$4.9327 for the current tax base.

The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of the estimate.

This tax levy is subject to the limits of section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution and the revenues raised will be used for governmental purposes other than schools.

Approval of this measure would reduce the property tax collections of other nonschool district units of government available under the provisions of section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution and implementing legislation.


Section 4. The election shall be conducted by the Clackamas County Elections Department, which department shall establish polling places, precincts, and election boards for such election. The election may be conducted by mail pursuant to ORS 254.465 et seq.

Section 5. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to certify in the manner provided for by law to the Elections Director of Clackamas County, Oregon, the foregoing measure for inclusion as a part of the regular ballots to be prepared by the Elections Director for voting at all precincts within the City of Milwaukie at the special election on May 19, 1992.

Section 6. The City Recorder shall be, and is hereby further authorized and directed to give notice of receipt of the ballot title as required by ORS 250.275, by publishing in the Enterprise-Courier on March 20, 1992.

Section 7. The City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie is hereby ordered and directed to post notice of said election in a conspicuous place in City Hall. This notice shall be posted at least ten (10) days before the date set for the election. The City Recorder shall give additional notice of the aforesaid City election by publication at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the first publication to be not less than ten (10) days before the election. The notice shall contain the ballot title under which the question will appear on the ballot and shall set forth the time and place of said election.


