
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AND METRO TO UNDERTAKE A ONE YEAR PILOT PROJECT TO INCORPORATE ENERGY, WATER AND OTHER MATERIAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION STRATEGIES INTO THE REGULAR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CITY FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the city and Metro are committed to conservation of water, energy and other material resources; and

WHEREAS, the city and Metro share the goal of educating city employees, residents and commercial businesses regarding conservation strategies;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Milwaukie authorize the City Manager to sign an intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Metro to undertake a one year pilot project to incorporate energy, water and other material resource conservation strategies into the regular operation and maintenance of the city facilities.
