

RESOLUTION NO. 41-1996

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF PROPOSED PROJECTS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie is desirous of undertaking certain public improvements that will affect low and moderate income residents, and which will result in improvements to existing public facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has been working with schools, neighborhoods and volunteers since January 1995 to identify safety improvements for children walking to and from local elementary schools, and these improvements include the installation of new sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie desires to improve the accessibility of our existing sidewalks for people in wheelchairs or otherwise disabled; and

WHEREAS, the North Clackamas Parks and Recreation District desires to make improvements to the stage at the Milwaukie Center, which is owned by the City of Milwaukie, and these improvements will make the stage accessible to the elderly and people with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the North Clackamas Parks and Recreation District seeks to make master plan improvements to Furnberg Park, which is also owned by the City of Milwaukie,

WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant funding is available, and a process is in place whereby the city's desired projects may be evaluated; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that the successful award of Community Development Block Grant funds requires a local match of twenty percent, said local match being available through the City and/or the Parks District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Milwaukie authorizes the submittal of the following proposed projects for consideration of Community Development Block Grant funding for the 1997 - 1999 funding cycle:

1. School Trip Safety Program Sidewalks
2. The Sidewalk ramp project; and

The City Council endorses two proposed projects of the North Clackamas Parks and Recreation District for consideration of Community Development Block Grant funding for the 1997 - 1999 funding cycle:

1. Wheelchair lift for the Milwaukie Center Stage
2. Master plan improvements for Furnberg Park
