

RESOLUTION NO. 4-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ADOPTING FISCAL YEAR 2000/2001 (YEAR ELEVEN) ANNUAL WASTE REDUCTION PLAN AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AN IGA WITH METRO.

WHEREAS, all local governments within the metropolitan area are required by the State through the leadership of Metro to provide an Annual Waste Reduction Work Plan,


WHEREAS, the Waste Reduction Work Plan for the City of Milwaukie is based on the Metro Regional Solid Waste Management Plan (RSWMP), and

WHEREAS, Metro has developed a new grant program for commercial recycling called the Commercial Technical Assistance Program which Milwaukie hopes will increase commercial recycling and waste reduction in the City, and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the need and importance of coordinated regional effort to ensure a fair and equitable distribution of the waste reduction efforts in our region,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE to adopt the attached Fiscal Year 2000-2001 Annual Waste Reduction Plan and to authorize the City Manager to sign an IGA with Metro granting the city \$8,849 in Metro Challenge Funds for implementation of this year's waste reduction tasks and \$10,000 in Commercial Technical Assistance Program funds .


