

RESOLUTION NO. 84-2008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE ATTACHED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE NORTH CLACKAMAS PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE CITY'S PARKS AND FACILITIES. THE IGA REPLACES THE 1992 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) BETWEEN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AND THE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie signed an IGA with the North Clackamas Parks and Recreation District in 1992 which established the relationship between the City and the Parks District and which guides the operation of the District and its Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the 1992 IGA effectively transferred the City's park equipment, park staff and the responsibility for operating its existing parks and recreation facilities and programs to the District; and

WHEREAS, the original IGA is now 15 years old and in need of significant updating;

WHEREAS, during the past 15 years the City has acquired additional land for parks, has developed new park facilities on its own and has made major progress toward construction of Milwaukie Riverfront Park;

WHEREAS, in May of 2006 Happy Valley voted to join the North Clackamas Parks District expanding the District's service area and scope of work; and

WHEREAS, the City Park Board, the District Advisory Board and the Milwaukie Center Community Advisory Board are all in support of the updated language for the attached IGA;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Manager is authorized to sign the attached Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the North Clackamas Parks and Recreation District for maintenance and operation of the city's parks and facilities. The IGA replaces the 1992 IGA between the City of Milwaukie and the District.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on October 21, 2008.


