The 38 meeting of the Common Council was called together by Mayor Shindler

Those present were Commissioner Strub - Trivory + Kelso - ^{Miss Lichten} ^{marked Dowling} minutes of last meeting was read + approved as read =

The first business of the meeting ordinance # 11 was read for the 1st time and a roll of the Council was called = Strub Yes Trivory Yes = Kelso Yes = it was then moved by Trivory + 2^d by Strub that the rules be suspended and a 2^d reading = Carried =

Strub Yes Trivory Yes = Kelso Yes it was then moved by Kelso that a 3^d reading be had = 2^d by Trivory + Carried Trivory Yes Strub Yes Kelso Yes = Carried then ordinance # 11 became a law =

ordinance # 12 was then read = moved by Strub + 2^d by Kelso + Carried that it be posted for 15 days =

Recorder Keck then appeared + asked that his resignation be accepted which was granted = it was then in order to Elect a new Recorder to fill the vacancy A Cooper read the nomination which was approved by the Council + He was Elected; Mr Keck was then appointed by Mayor Shindler to serve as night watch - without pay -
