

THE 95th. REGULAR MEETING.
Council Chamber, City Hall, Tuesday April 12th. 1910.

Council met in regular session, called to order by Mayor Streib, present Councilman Kelso, Stockton, Mullan, and Lehman the Recorder and Marshal. Minutes of the 95th regular and the adjourned meeting of ~~the~~ March 23d were read and approved

Health and Water Committee reported that they had investigated the complaints filed regarding certain cess-pools and toilets, and had found conditions as complained of and had instructed the Recorder to ~~notify~~ officially notify the interested parties to abate the nuisance.

On motion the Marshal was instructed to take charge of the City Hall collect all rents etc. and that he be allowed \$2.00 for every evening that hall was rented and that said amount be added to the regular charges of the hall.

A petition signed by property owners on Main St. praying for the improvement of same by gradeing, and then place some substantial surface or covering over same, was read to the Council. Definite action on same was left over untill next meeting.

A petition signed by all the property owners but one on Front St. praying for the improvement of same by placing hard service pavement the full length, was read to the council. Definite action on same was left over untill next meeting.

Ordinance No. 37 passed to third reading, duly and unanimously approved, and signed by the Mayor, and immediately became a law in full force and effect.

Ordinance No. 38 ordered reposted as corrected.

On motion Ordinance No. 39 was ordered published and posted according to law.

Ordinance No. 40 corrected to read to include improvement of walks and curbs, and was then ordered published and ~~post~~ ^{post} according to law.


On motion Street Committee was instructed to have two loads of gravel placed at the end of the plank ~~xxx~~ road on the Foster Road.

Ordinance No. 41 laid on the table untill the next meeting.

A committee from the Milwaukie Commercial Club addressed the Council and showed where the town could save at least 40% on the ~~xxx~~ crushed rock for the streets by having a portable rock crusher, the Council decided to investigate the matter further and report at next meeting.

On motion the Marshal was instructed to see the Portland Pound master and enquire what they would charge to come to Milwaukie and take up all dogs found running at large without a license, and report his findings to the Mayor and Recorder, and further to provide a place to keep the dogs and a manner for their disposal.

On motion the meeting adjourned to meet Thursday April 28th. 1910
