This is an opportunity to join the City's Community Development team and take part in shaping the City's ongoing revitalization. The City is searching for a Civil Engineer to act as the Construction Manager and provide internal and external leadership on the Portland-to-Milwaukie light rail project, a \$1.4 billion extension of the highly acclaimed metropolitan Portland MAX light rail system. This position will provide the City and TriMet with engineering review, field inspections, public utility oversight, and permitting assistance on the project through construction completion (estimated December 2014). The position will work closely with city, TriMet and contractor teams, spending time in both the city's office and TriMet's field office for the east segment. The position is responsible for protecting City of Milwaukie interests during the light rail construction project, including physical infrastructure, construction impacts to businesses and residents, and long term planning and maintenance considerations.

**Qualifications:** Thorough knowledge of civil engineering principles and demonstrated engineering competence in public utilities or transportation required. A Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering and 5 years of progressively responsible engineering experience, or an equivalent combination of education and experience is preferred. The ideal candidate will possess an Oregon Professional Engineering license, or a Professional Engineer license from another state, or be able to obtain Oregon license within 6 months from date of hire.

**Selection Process:** Applications will be screened to determine the candidates being invited to an interview. Preference will be given to those applicants who have direct and relevant education and/or work experience. Interviews may be scheduled as qualified applications are received. The First review of applications is July 30, 2012. Offers of employment are contingent upon successful completion of a pre-employment background screening, which may include a background check, drug screen and physical exam.

**Application Process:** All candidates must complete a City of Milwaukie employment application.
