 - 2) City's requirements
 - (a) present 3.3 mgd
 - (b) new area 1.5 mgd
2. Wichita Water District
- a) Proposal to dissolve
 - 1) Present program for service outside of city
 - 2) Present program for dissolution
 - 3) Present program for taking over all services within city limits
 - b) Contract for operation
 - 1) In the event dissolution does not mature, then the city should propose a contract to administer and operate the W. W. D.

3. Clackamas Water District

 - b) Proposal to purchase certain mains
 - 1) Harmony Road line from Pheasant Court to Lake Road (12" C. I. P.)
 - c) Prepare a proposal to be submitted to Clackamas Water District and effect a joint meeting to implement the proposal
 - d) Request a proposal from C. W. D. regarding pressure zones and storage
