COUNCIL CHAMBERS, FEBRUARY 7, 1938

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie held pursuant to the proceeding call of the Mayor, was held on the 7th day of February, 1938.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and on roll call the following answered: Present: Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Dell, Kirkpatrick, Ledding, Mourer and Roberts.

Councilman Ledding brought before the council the matter of making certain changes and alterations in the plans of the new City Hall Building so as to provide for a more spacious dormitory and a larger club room for the firemen and further to provide for an auditorium for civic activities. Mr. Ledding pointed out that these enlargements and additions were necessary and should be made part of the new building and that they could be secured presently for an estimated cost of \$2,596.00, whereas, if they were added on later, the cost would be necessarily much greater.

It was moved by Ledding, and seconded by Roberts, that the architect be instructed to prepare plans and specifications covering the purposed changes as discussed and to submit the same to the Public Works Administration and that an agreement be entered into with Joseph H. Anderson, contractor, for him to make such changes and alterations for a sum of \$2,596.00.

The roll call on the motion being taken, the following result was had:

Ayes: Dell, Kirkpatrick, Ledding, Mourer and Roberts.

Nayes: None.

Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Ledding, and seconded by Roberts, that the Recorder be authorized to execute such documents, on behalf of the city, as the Public Works Administration might require in connection with changes in plans and specifications for the construction of the New City Hall building.
