1. Letter was read from Clackamas County Housing Authority, dated January 29, 1971, enclosing letter from Department of Housing and Human Development, dated January 22, 1971, re low cost housing projects in Milwauke.
2. Letter was read from Sara Follen, Chairman of Metro Youth '71, dated January 29, 1971, re SECOND WIND, a youth-sponsored food drive in February, 1971. It was moved by Hupp, seconded by Martin, that the Council endorse the project and ask for cooperation of citizens in the area. Motion carried and so ordered.

1. Memo was read from Public Works Director dated February 2, 1971, regarding street opening permit fees. The City Manager was asked to prepare an amendment to the fee-setting ordinance.
2. Memo was read from the Public Works Director, dated February 2, 1971, re permit fees pertaining to city facilities, in particular a request from Clackamas County Public Works Department for a waiver of building permit and plan checking fees for Clackamas County Service District No. 1 construction.

the motion be tabled. Motion carried and so ordered.
