TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, FEB. 17TH. 1927.

An adjourned meeting of the two hundred ninety-ninth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 17th. day of February, 1927.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Miller. Present, Mayor Miller, Councilmen, Shindler, Schrock, Earl and Dell, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The Engineer having filed the proposed assessment for the improvement of Jefferson Street, upon motion duly made and carried, the 8th. day of March, 1927, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M. was set as the time and the Council Chamber as the place for hearing and considering objections to said apportionment. The City Engineer having filed with the Recorder the proposed assessments to pay the cost of the construction of the Milwaukie Sanitary Sewer; the Lake Road extension of the Milwaukie Sanitary Sewer and the Madison Street Sewer, upon motion duly made and carried, the 22nd. day of March, 1927, at the hour of 7:30 P. M. was the time and the Council Chamber as the place for hearing and considering objections to said proposed assessments. The bill of the City Engineer for preparing the assessments for the Sewers was read and laid on the table until the next regular meeting of the Council. The Recorder was authorized to employ the necessary help to prepare and mail the notices of the proposed sewer assessments. Councilman Dell of the Street Committee reported that a catch basin was badly needed at 21st and Adams Street, and that the Committee would recommend that a catch basin be installed at 21st and Adams Streets. Upon motion duly made and carried, the recommendation of the Street Committee was accepted and the Water Supt. was instructed to employ some suitable person to install a catch basin at 21st. and Adams Streets immediately. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Mayor was instructed to purchase an adding Machine for the City Treasurer at a cost not exceeding \$100.00.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to notify the Portland Electric Power Company to install a street lamp on the second pole north of Washington Street on 26th. Street,
