

MEETING OF MARCH 10, 1958

920th MEETING

The nine hundred twentieth regular meeting of the Council of Milwaukie, was held on the tenth day of March, 1958.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mullan.

Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Clay, Mortensen, Roberts and Klein; Manager Burdick, and Clerk Martin. Absent: Attorney Sheldahl.

The minutes of the nine hundred nineteenth regular meeting of the Council, held on the tenth day of February 1958, were approved as written.

The minutes of a special meeting of the Council, held on the fourteenth day of February, 1958, were approved as written.

The minutes of a special meeting of the Council, held on the seventeenth day of February, 1958, were approved as written.

The minutes of a special meeting of the Council, held on the seventh day of March, 1958, were approved as written.

Mr. D. Beeson, Chairman of the Milwaukie Fire Department Wage Committee; Mr. Jack Spencer, President of Local 1159, International Assn. of Fire Fighters; Mr. Rodney Davis, Vice President of Oregon State Fire Fighters; Mr. Frank Philpott, President of Clackamas County Central Labor Council and Mr. Richard House, Secretary of Local 1159, International Assn. of Fire Fighters, laid before the Council, their proposal for changes in wages, sick leave, vacations and clothing allowances. The Council members were given a pamphlet showing the scale of benefits received by the Fire Departments of other Cities and the Fire Districts not in incorporated cities, throughout the State; and these gentlemen requested that Milwaukie's Fire Department be put on a par with other Departments, giving the same service, in this State. The Council agreed to lay these facts and figures before the Budget Committee and assured these gentlemen that all their requests would be given consideration.

Mrs. Ross, Assistant Director of Civil Defense for Milwaukie, appeared before the Council and stated that she would need an office in the City Hall, to be equipped with a telephone, and that she would need funds for operational expenses of Civil Defense in this area. Mrs. Ross introduced Mr. H. Jackson, County Director of Civil Defense, who gave a report of their work being done in the County, and pointed out to the Council, the laws governing Civil Defense. When asked "Who appoints the Director of Civil Defense?" Mr. Jackson replied that the Council appointed the Director, who in turn appoints his own assistant. Mr. Jackson was advised that the Council had appointed Mr. Robert Lillis as Director of Civil Defense for Milwaukie. Mrs. Howard Hamlin, who was with a group of mothers in the Milwaukie area, and acted as spokesman for the same, requested that the Council give consideration to the Civil Defense as they felt it a necessary work. The Council took no action on the matter at this time.

Councilman Clay reported that he had made investigation of Franklin Street, between 42nd and Railroad Avenue, and that he had learned that a tract of land, east of Keil Heights, was soon to be developed and that Franklin Street would be extended into this development, which would make it a traveled street and he recommended that this end of the street be not vacated. It was moved by Clay and seconded by Mortensen that Franklin Street, between 42nd Street and Railroad Avenue be not vacated. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Klein that the City renew their contract with Pennsylvania Salt Company for furnishing liquid Chlorine for the Sewage Disposal Plant. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Mortensen and seconded by Roberts that the following bills be approved and that warrants be drawn for the payment of same.
