Motion carried and so ordered.

X It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Hamlin that Mrs. Leila Hall be granted a permit to construct a garage for temporary dwelling at Lots 7 & 8 Streib's First Addition. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Lester Ellis, 3836 Washington Street, made application for permit to build rabbit hutches on his property. The Mayor appointed Nelson, Hamlin and Roberts to make investigation and recommend if the permit should be granted.

It was moved by Hamlin and seconded by Roberts that the City sell the street grader to Louis B. Bruggman for \$300.00. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Hamlin and seconded by Roberts that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.

MEETING OF MARCH 12, 1945

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

624th MEETING

The six hundred twenty-fourth regular meeting of the Council was held on the twelfth day of March, 1945.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sperr.

Present: Mayor Sperr, Councilmen Hamlin, Nelson, Roberts and Rowe; Water Superintendent Counsell, Officer Butler and Recorder Martin.
Absent: Treasurer Walcott and Fire Chief Lewellyn.

The minutes of the six hundred twenty-third regular meeting of the Council, held on the twenty-sixth day of February, 1945, were read and approved as read.

It was moved by Nelson and seconded by Roberts that Mr. Lester Ellis be granted a permit to build rabbit hutches on Lots 5 to 10 inclusive, Block 74, Minthorn Addition. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. R. M. Church presented plans for a residence on Lot 3 Boley's Addition. It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Roberts that the permit be granted. Motion carried and so ordered.

Councilman Roberts made a report of different types of Water tanks for the City and stated that he and Councilman Nelson would contact the Government Salvage Department in the Pittock Block and consult the district U.S. Engineer there with regard to procuring an elevated water tank from the Government Salvage Department.

Water Superintendent Counsell pointed out to the Council that the water pumps and motors should be checked and any necessary repairs made at this time of year. It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Hamlin that the Water Commissioner be authorized to have any necessary repairs made to the motors and water pumps. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Nelson that the insurance policies on the pump houses be renewed with A. F. Huffman. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Nelson and seconded by Rowe that the City purchase two series "F" defense Bonds at \$740.00 each for the Water Department. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Hamlin that the Treasurer-Auditor financial report be accepted as presented. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Nelson that the Recorder be instructed to write a letter to George Flagg, of the Public Utilities Commission, calling his attention to the fact that the waiting room of the Portland Interurban Ry. Co. has been locked against the public for some time. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Hamlin that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
