The minutes of the last regular meeting and specials meetings were read and approved by the Council.

A petition for the improvement of Oak Street was read and ordered filed and upon motion the Engineer was instructed to furnish plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement for the same and estimates of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and submit the report to the next regular meeting.

Bonds of the Treasurer and Marshal were looked over and it was found that they read city of Milwaukie instead of town of Milwaukie, upon motion it was ordered that they be looked and approved of the corrections.

The Light Committee reported that the lights were being installed as asked for by the Council.

The fire Committee reported that they had not had time enough in which to investigate the matter of fire protection on Main Street. It was ordered that they be given until the next regular meeting to report.

The Report of the City Engineer furnishing plans and specifications for the improvement of Harrison Street and estimates of the work to be done thereon and the cost thereof were read and ordered filed, and the Council thereupon adopted the following resolution and ordered the same to be posted as required by the Charter. *Resolution*
