

TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, APRIL 25TH.1932.

An adjourned meeting of the regular three hundred sixty-first meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the 25th. day of April, 1932. Meeting called to order by Mayor Miller. Present, Mayor Miller, Councilmen Sanders, Dean, Bevington and Dell, Recorder Mathews and Marshall Keck. Mayor Miller stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposed ordinance granting the Portland General Electric Company a franchise, with the representatives of the Company who were present. The proposed franchise was read section by section and after a discussion thereof, the Council and the representatives of the Portland General Electric Company were unable to agree as to the terms of sections 2, 9 and 12 of the proposed franchise. Further consideration of the proposed ordinance was postponed until the next regular meeting of the Council. Upon motion duly made and carried, the meeting adjourned.

TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, MAY 9TH.1932.

The three hundred sixty-second regular meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the 9th. day of May, 1932. Meeting called to order by Mayor Miller. Present, Mayor Miller, Councilmen Sanders, Shindler, Dean, Bevington and Dell, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The minutes of the three hundred sixty-first regular meeting of the Council held on the 11th day of April, 1932, and the minutes of the adjourned meeting of the three hundred sixty-first regular meeting of the Council held on the 25th. day of April, 1932, were read and approved as read. The application of W. M. Rankin and L. M. Peden for a franchise to operate passenger busses over and along the Streets of Milwaukie for the purpose of carrying passengers for hire was read, as was also the application of the Milwaukie-Ardenwald Busses, Inc. for a similar franchise. After a discussion of the matter the Council requested both applicants to submit financial statements at an adjourned meeting of the Council to be held on the 17th. day of May, 1932. Mr. Wilkenson was granted permission to sell bakery goods produced by himself in East Milwaukie. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Mayor and Recorder were authorized to execute a Quitclaim deed on behalf of Milwaukie, conveying to the Security Savings and Trust Company of Portland, Oregon, all the right, title and interest the Town of Milwaukie has in and to Lots 13 to 24 inclusive in Block 41, Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland, Oregon, upon the payment of all the city liens including penalty, interest and cost of sale of said property. The City Engineer having filed in the office of the Recorder plans and specifications for the improvement of 31st Street as petitioned for, and estimates of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and said plans, specifications and estimates being satisfactory to the Council, the following resolution and Notice was read, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the resolution and notice was adopted as read:

Resolution and Notice of the improvement of 31st. Street from the South Side of Elmer Street to the North side of Madison Street.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of 31st. Street from the South side of Elmer Street to the north side of Madison Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, according to the petition therefor heretofore filed in the office of the Recorder, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and

Whereas, said plans, specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted. And Be It Further Resolved that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie, by its Council, to make said improvement, described as follows:

1. By constructing a cement concrete sidewalk four (4) feet in width on the east side of said 31st. Street from the south side of Elmer Street to the north side of Madison Street.
2. By constructing a standard curb on the east side of said 31st Street from the south side of Elmer Street to the north side of Madison Street
3. By constructing a full cement concrete round corner at the northeast corner of 31st. and Madison Streets.
4. By constructing three 8' X 6" cement concrete driveways from the curb to property line.

All work to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, and approved by this resolution.

The Recorder of Milwaukie is hereby directed to cause this Notice and Resolution to be posted as required by the City Charter.

Remonstrances against said proposed improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder on or before ten days from the 11th day of May, 1932.
