

MEETING OF APRIL 26, 1943.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

579th MEETING

The five hundred seventy ninth regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-sixth day of April 1943.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts, Councilmen, Newman, McClure, Sperr and Rowe, Attorney Adams, Fire Chief Steiner, Water Superintendent Counsell, Officer Rigdon, and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman Bevington, Treasurer Farrington, and Officers Shockley and Butler.

The minutes of the five hundred seventy-eighth regular meeting of the Council held on the twelfth day of April 1943, were read and approved as read.

Mr Sperr reported that he and Mr. McClure had employed two firemen, Mr. Arthur H. Steiner, to act as Chief at \$200.00 per month and Mr. Irvin Stevens to act as night man at \$175.00 per month. Mr. Steiner's first day of service was April 23, and Mr. Steven's first day was April 24.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by McClure that Mr. C.L. Sturtevant be paid \$80.00 for serving ten days as Fire Chief. Motion carried and so ordered.

There was some discussion about purchasing a motor driven lawn mower for the City. The Mayor appointed the following committee to make investigations of this matter. Mr. McClure, Mr. Rowe, and Mrs. Newman.

City Engineer, Ralph Milln, appeared before the Council and stated that the bridge to River Vista was a safe bridge and would take care of the loads it was intended to hold. He also stated that in his opinion the road was in good condition and that blading was all that it needed. Mr. Milln stated that in as much as the bridge could eventually become a financial burden to the City, he would suggest that the Council accept the plat with the exception of the bridge. After some discussion, Mr. J.S. Middleton, attorney for the Plattors, and City Attorney Adams, agreed that the Plat, as it now is, could not be accepted without the bridge. It was moved by McClure and seconded by Sperr that the Council not accept the Plat of River Vista, because of the financial responsibility to the City. Motion carried and so ordered.

A communication from the League of Oregon Cities was read.

A communication from the Council of Clackamas County Cities was read.

The Mayor requested each member of the Council to appoint a member to the City Budget Committee.

It was moved by Newman and seconded by Rowe that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
