

MEETING OF APRIL 24, 1944

603rd MEETING

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The six hundred third regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-fourth day of April 1944.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts; Councilmen Bevington, McClure, Sperr and Rowe. Water Superintendent Counsell, Assistant Fire Chief Stevens and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman Newman and Treasurer Farrington.

The minutes of the six hundred second regular meeting of the Council held on the tenth day of April 1944 were read and approved as read

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Sperr that Mr. E D Hammond be granted a permit to build an addition to a building on Lot 1 Block 1 Duerst's Addition provided that the west end of the building have a concrete foundation wall with fireproof outside covering on that part of the wall above the concrete. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that the County be permitted to use the City Hall as a polling place on May 19, 1944. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by McClure that Mr C F. Plummer be permitted to build a temporary fence on the sidewalk area at 1656 31st St. Motion carried and so ordered

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same

MINUTES OF MEETING OF MAY 8, 1944

604th MEETING

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The six hundred fourth regular meeting of the Council was held on the eighth day of May 1944.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts, Councilmen Newman, Bevington, Rowe and Sperr. Water Superintendent Counsell, Assistant Fire Chief Stevens and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman McClure and Treasurer Farrington.

The minutes of the six hundred third regular meeting of the Council, held on the twenty-fourth day of April, 1944, were read and approved as read.

The Mayor announced that the Budget Committee would meet on the seventeenth day of May 1944, for the purpose of discussing and preparing the Town Budget for the 1944-45 fiscal year, and asked the Council members to submit the names of their choice of Committee members to the Recorder. The following names were submitted:

The mayor read a letter from d.W. Hartwick in which he tendered his resignation as Police Officer of Milwaukie. The resignation to become effective May 31, 1944. It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Bevington that the resignation be accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Milwaukie Box and Veneer Co, represented by O.K.Mowat and Rex Caffall, laid plans of the factory they expect to build on the waterfront on the site of the old Hawley Pulp and Paper Mill, and asked that they be granted a building permit for same. After studying the plans it was moved by Bevington and seconded by Rowe that the permit be granted Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. C S Todhunter came before the Council and requested that there be an ordinance drawn whereby plumbing and electric wiring done in Milwaukie would be controlled through permits. After some discussion Mr Todhunter was asked to talk to different business men in Town and learn how they felt about licensing businesses in Milwaukie, and to bring a committee of business men before the Planning Commission at their June meeting for further discussion.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Newman that the city install a fire hydrant, for fire fighting purposes, on the west side of the Portland General Electric Company's right of way on the site of the old Hawley Pulp and Paper Mill property. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Peden, of the East Side Busses, came before the Council ^{Busses} and stated that his presence had been requested. After some discussion as to whether or not the Buss Company were to pay the Town of Milwaukie one hundred dollars annually in lieu of franchise fee, it was moved by Rowe and seconded by Newman that the matter be tabled until the next regular meeting of the Council. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Rowe reported that the Planning Commission recommended a manager form of government for Milwaukie, and would have the League of Oregon Cities draw up a model Charter, they also recommend that the matter be brought before the voters at a special election before long.

Mr Sperr brought before the Council an outline of the street repair work which should be done soon. It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Rowe that Mr.Sperr be authorized to repair and oil the streets, using whatever amount of funds are available at this time for that purpose, also using his own judgement as to which streets are to be repaired, and the extent of such repair work. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that the Treasurer-Auditor report be accepted as presented Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Newman that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
