

TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, MAY 10TH. 1927.

The three hundred second regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 10th. day of May, 1927. Meeting called to order by Mayor Miller. Present; Mayor Miller, Councilmen Shindler, Sanders, Shrock and Dell, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The minutes of the three hundred first regular meeting of the Council held on the 12th. day of April, 1927, and the minutes of the adjourned meeting of the three hundred first meeting regular meeting of the Council held on the 27th. day of April, 1927, were read and approved as read. Mrs. Forman was present and requested permission to use the East Milwaukie Fire Station temporarily for Sunday School purposes. Up motion duly made and carried, the request of Mrs. Forman was granted. Upon motion duly made and carried, Councilman Shrock was appointed a Committee of one to advertise and sell the old motors belonging to the Water Department.

Upon motion duly made and carried, Kerr & Shindler were allowed a refund of \$2.98 on the assessment for the Milwaukie Sanitary Sewer against the North 3 feet of Lot 6, Block 30, Milwaukie. Mr. Birkemeier was present and requested a building permit to erect a wooden building on the Lakin property on the corner of Monroe Street and Milwaukie Highway. The matter was referred to the Fire Committee to make a report on at the next meeting of the Council. A petition for the construction of a sewer on Oak Street from Elmer Street to Campbell Street was read and referred to the Sewer Committee for investigation. Petitions for the installation of street lamps at 40th & Washington Streets and at 42nd. & Monroe Streets were read and referred to the Light Committee.

The application of C. C. Mullan for a raise in salary to \$100.00 per month was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the application was laid on the table. Upon motion duly made and carried, Kerr & Shindler were granted permission to erect a 7 foot shed on the east end of their store building. The report of the Water Supt. was read and ordered placed on file. A communication from the State Fire Marshal recommending that a 6 inch water main be laid on 26th. Street from Monroe Street to Washington Street was read and referred to the Water Committee. The following bills were read and allowed by the Finance Committee and upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to draw warrants in payment of the same:
