

TOWN HALL MILWAUKIE OREGON MAY 14th, 1912.

The (122) Regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the above date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Streib. Present Mayor Streib, Councilmen Kelso, Lehman, and Knight, Recorder Goetz, and Marshall Davis.

The minutes of the (121) Regular meeting and also special meeting of May 2th were read and approved.

Bills were allowed as follows:-

Portland Railway Light and Power Co. for lights,	93.33
B. J. Staats for Road Tax,	5.00
Kelly Hardware Co. on account,	4.53
C. B. Davis, Marshall,	27.00
Louis C. Kelsey, ENgineer,	15.41
Portland Railway Light & Power Co. hauling gravel to be paid at the rate of 38 cents a yard as per agreement.	

Mrs Dunning complained to the Council that Mr. Fisch had failed to furnish them with water. It was moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Kelso that the petitioners be granted the right to lay Sellwoods mains across the Foster Road but that if the other two companies consolidated and furnished water the petitioners must use the company water. Carried.

Ordinance No. 70 being read for the second time. It was moved by Councilman Lehman and seconded by Councilman Kelso that ordinance No.70 be passed for second reading. Carried. Roll call showed the following results Ayes Councilmen Kelso, Lehman, Knight Councilman Stockton being absent. Nays none. The ordinance having passed the second reading moved by Councilman Kelso and seconded by Councilman Lehman that the ordinary rules be suspended and that the ordinance be taken up for the third and final reading. Carried. The ordinance having been read the roll call showed the following result. Ayes Councilmen Kelso, Lehman, and Knight. Councilman Stockton absent. Nays none. Ordinance passed.

Moved by Councilman Kelso and seconded by Councilman ^{String!} that condemnation proceedings be begun on the Harrison Road. Carried. The matter of securing a attorney to bring suit to condemn was referred to the Street Committee by Mayor Streib.

Moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Lehman that the Recorder notify Contractor W. H. Counsell that the Street Committee had condemned the sidewalk on the East side of Oak Street from the railroad south to Mrs. Wehdell's and that he must reconstruct it within ten days. Carried.

Moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Kelso that Louis C. Kelsey of Portland Oregon be appointed City Engineer

for the improvement of the Foster Road. Carried.

A petition for the improvement of the Foster Road was read and ordered filed . Moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Lehman that the City Engineer be ordered to draw plans and specifications and make estimates of the proable cost of the improvement of Foster Road from Main Street to Oatfeild Road. Carried.

No further business moved and seconded that we adjourn. Carried.
