COUNCIL CHAMBERS MAY 23, 1938

The four hundred sixty-sixth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 23rd day of May, 1938.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burdick.

Present: Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Kirkpatrick, Ledding, Mourer and Roberts, Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Stanley and Recorder Adams.

A communication from the Consolidated Supply Company requesting a meeting with the City Council was read and ordered filed.

C. B. Howard appeared before the Council and offered to pay \$165.00 as full payment of the Street and Sewer liens against Lots 14 and 15, Block 1, Quincy Addition to Milwaukie. It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Kirkpatrick that the offer be accepted, if paid in cash on or before June 15, 1938.

The Recorder announced that this was the time and place for considering the vacation of Harvey's Addition and hearing objections to such vacation. The Mayor stated that if there were any objections to the proposed vacation of Harvey's Addition that now was the time for such objections to be presented. There was no response.

It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Kirkpatrick that the Recorder prepare and post an ordinance providing for the vacation of Harvey's Addition to Milwaukie. Motion carried and so ordered.
