Jarvis Thompson, Jr., introduced A. C. McMicken of the Portland General Electric Company, who presented a proposed street lighting contract and left copies for study by the street lighting committee and city attorney.

It was moved by Kirkpatrick and seconded by Mourer that the action of the Council on the May 20, 1940, meeting in accepting the resignation of E. A. Stanley be confirmed. Motion carried and so ordered.

W. S. Hewitt, Engineer, described the tank known as the Hewitt tank.

It was moved by Rivers and seconded by Rudder that the preparation of plans for a 6,000 gallon Hewitt water tank and submission of the same to the regional engineers of WPA be authorized. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Recorder brought up the question of the issuance of \$15,000 bonds as authorized by the Street Bond amendment adopted by the voters on May 17, 1940. It was moved by Kirkpatrick and seconded by Rivers that the matter of issuance of \$15,000 bonds as authorized by the Street Bond Amendment adopted by the voters on May 17, 1940, be layed on the table indefinitely. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mary Keil stated that her family had purchased Lot 47, Block 69, Minthorn Addition, from the County and would like first opportunity to purchase said lot upon the City completing its suit to quiet title to the same. It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Kirkpatrick that the request be granted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Kirkpatrick that James Rigdon be appointed Marshal and that he be paid the regular Marshal's salary of \$2 per month. Motion carried and so ordered.

Upon motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.

The five hundred fourteenth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 10th day of June, 1940.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

The minutes of the five hundred twelfth and five hundred thirteenth regular meetings of the Council, held respectively on the 13th and 27th days of May, 1940, and of the special meeting of the Council held on the 20th day of May, 1940, were each read and were each approved as read.

The Treasurer's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.
