Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the recorder of said Town on or before ten days from the 3rd day of June 1920. The Town Recorder is hereby directed to cause this notice and resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Upon motion duly made and carried, ordinance No. 164, entitled, "An ordinance amending section fifteen (15) of ordinance number 161 as amended by ordinance number 162," was taken up for passage. The ordinance being read the roll call showed the following result: Ayes, Albee, Miller, Hart and Counsell. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 164 passed the first reading. Upon motion duly made and carried, the rules were suspended and ordinance No. 164 was taken up for the second reading and read by title only. The roll call showed the following result: Ayes, Albee, Miller, Hart and Counsell. Nays, None. Ordinance No. 164 passed the second reading. Upon motion duly made and carried, the rules were suspended and ordinance No. 164 was taken up for the third and final reading and read by title only. The roll call showed the following result: Ayes, Albee, Miller, Hart and Counsell. Nays, none. Ordinance No. 164 passed.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to prepare an ordinance prohibiting the blocking or obstructing streets and highways in Milwaukie, also to prepare a traffic ordinance.

Town Hall, Milwaukie, Oregon, June 14th. 1920.

An adjourned meeting of the two hundred nineteenth regular meeting of the Council was held on the above named date. Meeting called to order by Mayor Snyder. Present, Mayor Snyder, councilmen, Miller, Grasle and Hart and recorder Mathews. There being no remonstrances made or filed against the improvement of 24th Street, upon motion duly made and carried, ordinance No. 165 entitled, "An ordinance providing for the improvement of 24th Street, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, from the north line of a sixteen foot pavement to be laid in Harrison Street thence northerly along the center line of said 24th street for an approximate distance of 557 feet, and declaring an emergency," was read and ordered posted as required by the City Charter. Upon motion duly made and carried, ordinance No. 166 entitled, "An ordinance prohibiting the blockading or obstructing the streets, alleys, and public highways in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, prohibiting the dumping of material therein: repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and providing a penalty for the violation of the provisions hereof", was read and ordered posted as required by the City Charter. A communication from the S. F. Co. in regard to the drain under its track on Harrison Street was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the Street Committee was instructed to have the Town's portion of the work done. The following bills were read and allowed by the Finance Committee and the Recorder was instructed to draw warrants in payment of the same:
