It was moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Kelso that Ordinance No. 73 be taken up for first reading. Carried. Ordinance No. 73 being read, roll call showed the following results, Ayes Councilmen Kelso, Knight, Lehman, Stockton. Nays none. The Ordinance having passed the first reading, moved by Councilman Kelso and seconded by Councilman Stockton that the Ordinance be taken up for the second reading. Carried. Ordinance No. 73 being read roll call showed the following results, Ayes Councilmen Kelso, Knight, Lehman, and Stockton. Nays none. The Ordinance having passed the second reading moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Lehman that the ordinary rules be suspended and that the Ordinance be taken up for the third and final. Carried. The Ordinance being read the roll call showed the following results. Ayes Councilman Kelso, Knight, Lehman, and Stockton. Nays none. Ordinance passed.

Moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Lehman that Ordinance No. 74 Entitled: "An Ordinance granting to the Portland Railway Light and Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct acquire own and maintain, operate and use railways and street railways in the Town of Milwaukie" be posted. Carried.

Moved by Councilman Knight and seconded by Councilman Stockton that Ordinance No. 75 entitled: An Ordinance regulating the construction, erection, alteration, repair and use of buildings for moving picture shows; nickelodians, or machanical shows of any kind and to provide for protection against fire, and providing a penalty for the violation of same, be passed. Carried.

No further business moved and seconded that council adjourn. Carried.
