

TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, SEPT. 8TH. 1930.

The three hundred forty-second regular meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the 8th. day of September, 1930. Meeting called to order by Mayor Miller. Present, Mayor Miller, Councilmen Shindler, Sanders, Dean and Dell, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The minutes of the three hundred forty-first regular meeting of the Council held on the 11th day of August, 1930, and the minutes of the adjourned meeting of the three hundred forty-first regular meeting of the Council held on the 25th. day of August, 1930, were read and approved as read.

Upon motion duly made and carried, School District No. 1 was given permission to use the upstairs of the City Hall for gymnasium classes during the present school year for the rent of \$5.00 per month, the School to pay for all lights and fuel used by it and for janitor service and to pay all damages which may result from the use of the same for gymnasium classes. Mr. Carter was present and requested the Council to take some action in regard to the violations of the traffic ordinance, either by putting up stop and slow signs, or by putting on a traffic officer. He advised the Council that the automobiles were operating their cars on 31st and Elmer's Streets at a rate of speed between 45 miles and 60 miles per hour. Upon motion duly made and carried, the matter of employing a traffic officer was referred to Councilman Dean with full power to act. The application of J. A. Keck for a ten days vacation with pay was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the application of Mr. Keck was granted. The application of Hnery Wiseman for a two weeks vacation with pay was read, and upon motion duly made and carried, the application of Mr. Wiseman was granted.

The Street Supt. was instructed to repair the sewer. The report of the City Treasurer was read and ordered placed on file.
