COUNCIL CHAMBERS, AUGUST 23, 1937

The four hundred forty-ninth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 23rd day of August, 1937. Present: Councilmen Burdick, Dell, Mourer and Roberts; Water Superintendent Bevington; Marshal Stanley, Fire Chief Lewellyn; and Recorder Adams.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council Burdick.

Ordinance No. 380 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of Milwaukie City Hall Bonds in the sum of Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000.00), dated as of October 1, 1937, of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon" was taken up for consideration and read for the second and third time, and put on its passage with the following result being had:

Ayes: Burdick, Dell, Mourer and Roberts

Nays: None. Ordinance No. 380 passed the Council.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Roberts that the First State Bank of Milwaukie be designated as the depository for funds received from the sale of City Hall Bonds and all other funds received for use in connection with the construction of the new city hall building. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Roberts that Walter E. Kelley be employed as architect on the new City Hall. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Dell that William Adams be employed to handle the legal work in reference to the financing and construction of the new City Hall. Motion carried and so ordered.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, SEPTEMBER 13, 1937

The four hundred fiftieth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 13th day of September, 1937.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Roberts that the Architects fee on the new City Hall be set at six percent of the cost of construction of said building as finally audited by the Federal government and that the Mayor and Recorder be authorized to enter a contract with Mr. Kelly covering his services as such architect. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Roberts that the Attorney's fee relative to proceedings concerning the new City Hall be set at one and a half percent of the construction cost as finally audited by the Federal Government and that the Mayor and Recorder be authorized to enter into a contract with W. Adams covering his services as such attorney. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Mourer that the following bills be approved and that the Recorder issue warrants covering the same.
