

## TOWN HALL, MILWAUKIE, OREGON, OCT. 12TH. 1926.

The two hundred ninety-fifth regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie was held on the 12th. day of October, 1926.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Cowell. Present, Mayor Cowell, Councilmen Ramsey, Kerr, Grasle, Frey and Hazen, Recorder Mathews and Marshal Keck. The minutes of the two hundred ninety-fourth regular meeting of the Council held on the 14th. day of September, 1926, and the minutes of the adjourned meetings of the two hundred ninety fourth regular meeting of the Council held on the 18th. 21st and 24th. day of September, 1926, were read and approved as read. Upon motion duly made and carried, Attorney W. P. La Roche was employed to represent the Town of Milwaukie in the case of Anna Miller, plaintiff, vs. The Town of Milwaukie, Defendant.

The petition of property owners residing on Lake Road requesting the Council to install an arc light at 28th. Street and Lake Road was read. Upon motion duly made and carried, the Recorder was instructed to notify the P. E. P. Co. to install a street lamp at the intersection of Lake Road and Outfield Road, and to remove the street lamp now in front of Mr. Holmes' property to the intersection of 27th. Street and Lake Road, and to remove the street lamp now located in front of Miss Millard's property to a point midway between 27th. Street on Lake Road and the Outfield Road. The matter of granting Mr. Sims a permit to erect a temporary shed on Front Street was laid on the table until the next meeting of the Council. A petition of property owners along 26th. Street, requesting the Council to pave 26th. Street from Monroe Street to Washington Street to a width of 16 feet, was read and upon motion duly made and carried, it was ordered that said street be paved as requested, if there is sufficient money in the paving fund to pay for the same. Upon motion duly made and carried, it was ordered that \$4500.00 be transferred from the Water Fund to the General fund, said amount to be paid back to the Water fund on or before the 1st day of July, 1927. Upon motion duly made and carried, the City Engineer was instructed to meet with Mr. Riley and inspect 22nd Street in front of the Union High School and make a report to the Council the best way to prevent the surface water from draining on private property.
