COUNCIL CHAMBERS

SPECIAL MEETING

A special meeting of the City Council was held on November 7, 1967, at the call of the Mayor, for the purpose of providing for the payment of sanitary sewer service and inspection fees and connection fees, and for any other business to come before the Council at this time.

ORDINANCE NO. 1166

It was moved by Slominski, seconded by Clore, that Ordinance No. 1166, be taken up for its first reading Motion carried and so ordered.

After reading, it was moved by Graf, seconded by Strauss, that Ord. No. 1166, be moved to its second reading at this time by title only. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ord. No. 1166, (AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SANITARY SEWER SERVICE AND INSPECTION FEES AND CONNECTION FEE; PROVIDING FOR RELIEF THEREFROM AND ESTABLISHING LIENS FOR DELINQUENT FEES AND CHARGES), was put on its passage with the following roll call vote: AYES: Strauss, Slominski, Graf, Clore and Richmond. NOES: None. Ord. No. 1166 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

RESOLUTION NO. 38-1967

It was moved by Graf, seconded by Slominski, that Resolution No. 38-1967, (ESTABLISHING SANITARY SEWER CONNECTION FEE AND SERVICE AND INSPECTION FEES), be read and adopted. Motion carried and so ordered.

AWARDING OF BID

It was moved by Graf, seconded by Strauss, that the bid contract on Sewer Construction on 43rd Street, be awarded to Jack's Digger Service, (low bidder), provided he presents the City with an adequate bond. Motion carried and so ordered.

As there was no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was duly adjourned.
